- The downloading of Application form for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree Courses 2023 2024 session under All India Quota Seats in IM & H Self Financing Medical Colleges can be accessed from the following official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in. Candidates should submit their downloaded duly filled in application form with all enclosures along with the details regarding the SBI collect transaction ID and submit the copy of receipt of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) towards the cost of application form. The procedure of online payment is mentioned in Clause 25 of this prospectus.
- The admissions in the State of Tamil Nadu are as per the provisions of the Government of Tamil Nadu and in compliance to the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and the National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) and shall be solely based on marks obtained in the National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test (NEET (UG) 2023) conducted by NTA.
- As per the prevailing regulations, the seat matrices for admission in the Self-Financing Institutions shall be **fifteen percent for the All India Quota** for the academic year 2023 2024.

1 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: -

Candidate should be a citizen of India.

2 AGE LIMIT (For details kindly refer clause 16.1.1.C. of NEET UG – 2023 Bulletin):

No candidate shall be admitted to BSMS / BAMS / BUMS / BHMS Degree Course unless one has attained the age of **Seventeen Years** on or before the **31st December**, 2023 for admission in the first year of the course and there is no upper age limit.

3 EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- (i) Admissions to all State Quota seats of Undergraduate Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy Courses will be done through NEET (UG) 2023 as per the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education), Regulations 2022, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education), Regulations 2022 and National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education), Regulations 2022, and National Commission for Homoeopathy (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course BHMS) Regulations 2022 (NCISM & NCH are Regulatory Bodies of the above-mentioned Courses under the Ministry of AYUSH).
- (ii) In order to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th Percentile in NEETUG-2023. However in respect of candidates belonging to OBC / SC / ST, the minimum marks shall be at 40th Percentile in NEETUG-2023. In respect of candidates with Persons with Benchmark disabilities alone the minimum marks shall be at 45th Percentile for General Category candidates and 40th Percentile for OBC / SC / ST candidates in NEET UG-2023.

Note:

Provided further that where sufficient number of candidates in the respective category fail to secure minimum marks in the National Eligibility – cum – Entrance Test held for any academic year for admission to undergraduate programme, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine & National Commission for Homoeopathy, in consultation with the Central Government may at its

discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to undergraduate programme for candidates belonging to respective category and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) Further, to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses, Candidates must have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by Any State Board or any other equivalent Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of **fifty percent** of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and **forty percent** mark in the case of OBC / SC / ST category. In respect of **Persons with Benchmark disabilities** candidates the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology shall be **forty five percent** in the case of general category and **forty percent** in the case of OBC / SC / ST.

NOTE:- Candidates who have passed any other equivalent examinations other than the Tamil Nadu State Board Examination, CBSE and ICS with same subjects as mentioned above in clause **3** (iii) should produce the eligibility certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University before the counselling date or before attending the counselling.

(iv) Candidates qualified in the NEET (UG) - 2023 and who have passed the qualifying examinations from *National Institute of Open Schooling* or *State Open Schools* or *as private candidates* from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions/ Appeals filed by the Medical Council of India. (As per NEET (UG) 2023 Guidelines)

Note: * "The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The provisions of the regulations disqualifying recognized Open School Board candidates and the candidates who have studied Biology/Biotechnology as an Additional Subject has been struck down."

(v) Language qualification for BSMS Course

In addition to the required minimum percentile in the NEETUG-2023.

a. The candidate should have studied in Tamil medium up to X or XII Standard, or

- **b.** The candidate should have studied Tamil as a subject up to X or XII Standard, or
- **c.** The candidate must be prepared to pursue the study of Tamil Language as a subject during the First professional course of B.S.M.S. course, to become eligible to take the other subjects examination of the BSMS Course.

4 INELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The following categories of candidates are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to apply for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses.

- a. Candidates who have passed H.Sc. in Vocational Stream and who have passed Pre-University Course in Tamil Nadu.
- b. The selection and admission of candidates of other than those in Clause 3 (iii) will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any grounds, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will be cancelled.
- c. Candidates presently pursuing the B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. Courses are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses during this academic year.
- The tentative lists of Self-Financing Medical Colleges are furnished with the details of Courses offered and Tentative seats available under All India Quota in the Annexure I.

6 DURATION OF THE BSMS / BAMS / BHMS COURSES:

5 1/2 years of study including one year Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship.

7 METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:

- (i) The admission shall be made on the basis of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test **NEET UG-2023** score for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses for the year 2023 2024 for the Seats under All India Quota in Self Financing IM & H Medical Colleges.
- (ii) Rank List of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in **NEET UG-2023**. Further, Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the tentative rank list on the following official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in and candidates shall be admitted to the above courses from the said rank list **ONLY**.
- 8 All selections and admissions for BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Courses are only provisional. The Selection and admission is liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be

defective or incorrect or of any suppression of facts deliberately or otherwise. The right of allotment to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS courses and Colleges is vested totally with the Selection Committee.

9 COUNSELLING (Single Window System):

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- a. Selection Committee is the designated authority for counselling for all admissions to undergraduate courses in Siddha, Ayurveda, Homoeopathy and Unani medicine in all Government, Self-financing ASUH Institutions of Tamil Nadu. (except for government seats in AIQ)
- b. No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the undergraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by NCISM / NCH in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged.
- c. The authority or Institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of provisions of the NCISM sand NCH regulation 2022.

Selection will be made based on NEET UG-2023 score and by following Single Window System during counselling. Counselling schedule will be available only on the official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in

- (i) Candidates should attend the counselling session as per the schedule and as per their rank as mentioned official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in only.
- (ii) One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session. Also use of Mobile Phones will be strictly prohibited in the Counselling Hall.
- (iii) Candidates will be called for counselling as per their rank and they may exercise their option as per their eligibility norms mentioned in the Prospectus.
- (iv) Option once exercised during counselling, will be final and cannot be changed.
- (v) Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their names will not be considered later. However he / she can authorize his / her parent on his / her behalf for that phase of counselling due to unavoidable circumstances and the parent's decision will be binding on the candidate. An Authorization letter given by candidate should be submitted by the parents along with the original documents of any one of the identification proof such as Voter ID, Driving Licence, Pan Card / Passport of both the parent and the candidate as mentioned in the Annexure VA and VB.

- (vi) Seat under All India Quota (AIQ) will be open in nature and there shall not be any requirement for domicile in a particular State / UT or passing of 10+2 in a particular State / UT.
- (vii) Rules as applicable for the All India Quota seats as per the prevalent NCISM / NCH rules and regulations, State Policy and the relevant rules of institutions applicable to the Self Financing All India Quota will apply.
- (viii)(a) All Communications regarding Counselling will be displayed / available through the official website only and any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available immediately on the website www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in.
 - (b) The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of release of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses under All India Quota 2023 2024 session.
- (ix) (a) Candidates can exercise their option for the course and the college of their own choice at the time of counselling, and allotment is subject to availability of seats.
 - (b) Individual request for transfer of College or change of course will not be allowed after allotment of seat is made during the same phase of counselling. A candidate is eligible for re-allotment only during subsequent phase of counselling based on rank and one should have joined the Self-Financing College to which one was allotted under All India Quota during earlier phase of Counselling.
- (x) The vacancies arising after the All India Quota Counselling will be converted into State Quota and it will be filled by the State Government as per rules and policies of Government of Tamil Nadu.
- (xi) Counselling/allotment for the seats newly created due to provision of seat matrix after the commencement of first phase counselling by the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University or due to the orders/interim orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court Madras after the commencement of 1st phase counselling will be done only during 2nd phase of counselling, but within the cut-off date of UG Courses admission as laid down by the regulatory bodies viz. MoA/NCISM/NCH.
- (xii) Mutual transfers will not be allowed under any circumstances.
- (xiii) The candidate is eligible to opt for any of the courses viz. BSMS / BAMS / BHMS under All India Quota in Self-financing colleges based on his/her eligibility and merit marks obtained in NEET 2023.
- (xiv)Those who obtained allotment order to a particular course in a Self-Financing college under All India Quota during the counselling do not join within the stipulated time to that particular course

and college to which they are allotted, will not be considered for admission at any point of time later.

(xv) Counselling schedule will be made available on the website only.

(xvi) COVID INSTRUCTION:-

The candidates and their parents are instructed to follow the standard preventive measures of COVID-19 as per Government orders from time to time.

- (a) Detailed information regarding Caution Deposit, Scholarship, Fee Concession, Hostel Fees, if availed, University Registration Fees, Examination Fees, etc. can be obtained from the Head of the Institution in which the candidate joins.
- (b) All the candidates attending IM & H UG courses counselling for All India Quota seats will have to remit a non-refundable amount of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) as cash towards processing fee for Counselling before signing attendance register meant for participating in the counselling.
- (c) The candidates who are selected at the time of counselling (Under All India Quota Seats in Self-Financing IM & H College) shall remit a **non-refundable sum of Rs.25,000/-** (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) towards tuition fees **as cash** at the time of receipt of the allotment orders. After the conduct of **Registration Subcommittee meeting** by the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University this amount will be transferred to the Self Financing Medical Colleges concerned to get adjusted against the Tuition Fees to be paid by the candidates.

If the candidate fails to join the course after getting allotment order under All India Quota Seats within the stipulated time he/she will forfeit this amount and the seat allotted.

Same passport size photograph which was uploaded in NEET UG-2023 examination must be fixed in the application form. It should also be pasted in the attendance sheet maintained at the counselling hall and also should be submitted at the time of admission at the allotted College.

13 All the entries in the application form should be written legibly by the candidate in his/her own handwriting. The candidate should ensure that all information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him/her in the application and the enclosure are correct. The candidate is informed that after proper scrutiny of his/her application, it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct or any other information is found to be incorrect, then; a. He/She will forfeit the admission no matter at what stage of the course he / she will be at that time; b. He/She will be debarred from pursuing any studies for a period of three years; c. Legal action will be initiated against the candidate and the parents for furnishing incorrect information; d. Criminal action will be instituted against him/her for furnishing false Mark Sheets etc., 14 Documents enclosed with the application will not be returned. Candidates are required to **enclose One** set of Self - attested Photo copies of the certificates as in the check list along with the application. 15 The selection and admission of candidates of other Universities / Boards will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any ground, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will stand cancelled. 16 The Selected Candidates should produce all the original documents at the time of counselling for verifying the Self attested Photo Copies. Further the Selected Candidates should produce all the original documents at the time of admission to the Principal of the Medical Colleges concerned. Selection will be cancelled if the candidates do not produce the original documents at the time of admission. 17 Selected candidates should produce a Physical Fitness Certificate obtained from a Registered Medical Practitioner not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon / Assistant Medical Officer of Government Hospital at the time of joining the course. 18 **Hepatitis-B vaccination:** All candidates selected for admission to first year BSMS / BAMS / BHMS course should take the Hepatitis-B Vaccine before admission to these Courses and only on producing a certificate in Annexure – II, the Principals will admit the candidates. The students should take further doses at the

prescribed intervals as required.

19 **DISCONTINUATION FEES:** (i) Candidates selected for admission and his/her parent /guardian will have to execute an Agreement Bond as prescribed in Annexure–III. Failure to execute the Agreement Bond will lead to cancellation of selection. (ii) Candidates who discontinue the course on or after the last cut off date for admission process for the academic session 2023 - 2024 and on any date of the subsequent years are bound by the bond and thereby they shall have to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) as penalty for having breached the contract in the bond by means of Demand Draft in favour of "The Director of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai-106" payable at Chennai. Note: This penalty is only for candidates who discontinue the course and not for re-allotment and movement from one to another category. 20 Enquiry or any correspondence regarding the selection of candidates will not be entertained. 21 Ragging: The Candidates who join BSMS/BAMS/ BHMS Course should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging. If they are found to have indulged in ragging in past or noticed later, the candidates will be removed from roll of institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against the candidates. 22 The Government orders issued and to be issued from time to time pertaining to any of the matters contained in the prospectus should be read as part and parcel of this prospectus and such terms and conditions in the Government order are deemed to have been incorporated in this prospectus. 23 No admission, re-allotment / transfer shall be made after cut-off date for the academic year as per the guidelines issued by the NCISM, NCH and Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.
