As a part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, a Free Medical Camp was organized by Nandha Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Erode in association with Jeevitham Foundation at Gobichettipalayam, Tamilnadu, on 20th March 2022. The whole programme began at 8.00 am and came to an end at 5.30pm.

Main aim of the camp was to rehabilitate the homeless wanderers on the streets, by providing food, make-over, medical checkup and counseling. Initially the volunteers of Jeevitham foundation approached the homeless people wandering in and around Erode and done makeover by giving bath, shaving the beard and head, and providing new cloths. Then they were provided with a delicious lunch.

Later the free medical care was given from 2pm to 3.30 pm. Dr. Hema. V and Dr. Divya. S lead the camp by providing general examination, screening of illnesses, free medicines and minor therapeutic procedures like wound cleaning.

The day continued with the counseling section conducted by Psychiatrist Dr. Praneesh. Totally 15 abandoned were rescued and provided with medical care in which many of them were wounded and many were suffering with psychiatric illnesses.

At the end of the programme the doctors and the organizers of the programme were felicitated for their dedication and service. The camp was a blessing for many who were abandoned and was a huge inspiration for the society.
