- The downloading of Application form for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree Courses 2022 2023 session under All India Quota Seats In IM & H Self Financing Medical Colleges can be accessed from the following official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in. Candidates should submit their downloaded duly filled in application form with all enclosures along with the details regarding the SBI collect transaction ID and submit the original receipt of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) towards the cost of application form. The procedure of online payment is mentioned in Clause 25 of this prospectus.
- The admissions in the State of Tamil Nadu are as per the provisions of the Government of Tamil Nadu and in compliance to the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education In Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2018 and the Homoeopathy (Degree Course) Amendment Regulations, 2018 shall be based solely on marks obtained in the National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG-2022)
- As per amended Regulations, the seat matrices for admission in the Self-Financing Institutions shall be **fifteen percent for the All India Quota** for the academic year 2022 2023.

1 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

Candidate should be a citizen of India.

2 AGE LIMIT (For Details kindly refer clause 5.1.2 of NEET UG – 2022 Bulletin) :

As per amended regulations No candidate shall be admitted to BSMS / BAMS / BUMS / BHMS Degree Course unless one has attained the age of **Seventeen Years** on or before the **31**st **December**, 2022 for admission in the first year of the course and there is no upper age limit.

3 EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- (i) In compliance to the amended rules & regulations as effected by NCISM & NCH with prior sanction of the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India through their Notifications on 10/12/2018 & 17/12/2018 in the Gazette of India Extra ordinary respectively, the eligibility for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic year shall be based solely on marks obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEETUG 2022) conducted by NTA, New Delhi.
- (ii) In order to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th Percentile in NEETUG-2022. However in respect of candidates belonging to OBC / SC / ST, the minimum marks shall be at 40th Percentile in NEETUG-2022. In respect of candidates with Persons with Benchmark disabilities alone the minimum marks shall be at 45th Percentile for General Category candidates and 40th Percentile for OBC / SC / ST candidates in NEET UG-2022.
- (iii) a. Further, to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BUMS / BHMS Degree courses, Candidates must have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board or any other equivalent Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of **fifty percent** of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and **forty percent** of marks in the case of ST / SCA / SC / MBC / DC / BCM and BC category. In respect of Candidates with Benchmark Disabilities the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology shall be **forty five percent** in the case of general category and **forty percent** in the case of ST / SCA / SC / MBC / DC / BCM and BC candidates.
 - b. If sufficient number of candidates in respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in NEET (UG) 2022, the Central Government in consultation with National Council for Indian System of Medicine and National Council for Homoeopathy under its discretion may lower the minimum marks required for admission to UG Courses for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for the academic year 2022-23 only. If reduction of marks occur separate application will be called for and admissions will be made as per merit ad rule of reservation.

(iv) Candidates qualified in the NEET (UG) - 2022 and who have passed the qualifying examinations from *National Institute of Open Schooling* or *State Open Schools* or *as private candidates* from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions/ Appeals filed by the Medical Council of India. (As per NEET (UG) 2022 Guidelines)

Note: * "The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The provisions of the regulations disqualifying recognized Open School Board candidates and the candidates who have studied Biology/Biotechnology as an Additional Subject has been struck down."

(v) Language qualification for BSMS Course

In addition to the required minimum percentile in the NEETUG-2022

- a. The candidate should have studied in Tamil medium up to X or XII Standard, or
- b. The candidate should have studied Tamil as a subject up to X or XII Standard, or
- **c.** The candidate must be prepared to pursue the study of Tamil Language as a subject during the First professional course of B.S.M.S. course, to become eligible to take the other subjects examination of the BSMS Course.

4 INELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The following categories of candidates are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to apply for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses.

- a. Candidates who have passed H.Sc. in Vocational Stream and who have passed Pre-University Course in Tamil Nadu.
- b. The selection and admission of candidates of other Universities / Boards will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any grounds, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will be cancelled.
- c. Candidates presently pursuing the B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. Courses are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses during this academic year.
- The tentative lists of Self-Financing Medical Colleges are furnished with the details of Courses offered and Tentative seats available under All India Quota in the Annexure I.
 - 6 DURATION OF THE BSMS / BAMS / BHMS COURSES:

5 1/2 years of study including one year Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship.

7 METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:

- (i). The admission shall be made on the basis of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test **NEET UG-2022** score for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses for the year 2022 2023 for the Seats under All India Quota in Self Financing IM & H Medical Colleges.
- (ii). Rank List of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in **NEET UG-2022**. Further Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the tentative rank list on the following official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in and candidates shall be admitted to the above courses from the said rank list **ONLY**.

- All selections and admissions for BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Courses are only provisional. The Selection and admission is liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be defective or incorrect or of any suppression of facts deliberately or otherwise. The right of allotment to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS courses and Colleges is vested totally with the Selection Committee.
- 9 COUNSELLING (Single Window System):

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- a. Selection Committee is the designated authority for counseling for all admissions to undergraduate courses in Siddha, Ayurveda, Homoeopathy and Unani medicine in all Government, Self Financing ASUH Institutions of Tamil Nadu.
- b. No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the undergraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by Selection Committee in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged.
- c. The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of provisions of the NCISM and NCH Amendment Regulation 2018.

Selection will be made based on NEET UG-2022 score and by following Single Window System during counselling. Counselling schedule will be available only on the official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in

- (i). Candidates should attend the counselling session as per the schedule and as per their rank as mentioned official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in only.
- (ii). One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session. Also use of Mobile Phones will be strictly prohibited in the Counselling Hall.
- (iii) Candidates will be called for counselling as per their rank and they may exercise their option as per their eligibility norms mentioned in the Prospectus.
- (iv) Option once exercised during counselling, will be final and cannot be changed.
- (v) Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their names will not be considered later. However, he / she can authorize his / her parent on his / her behalf for that phase of counselling due to unavoidable circumstances and the parent's decision will be binding on the candidate. An Authorization letter given by candidate should be submitted by the parents along with the original documents of any one of the identification proof such as Voter ID, Driving Licence, Pan Card / Passport of both the parent and the candidate as mentioned in the Annexure VA and VB.
- (vi) Seat under All India Quota (AIQ) will be open in nature and there shall not be any requirement for domicile in a particular State / UT or passing of 10+2 in a particular State / UT.
- (vii)Rules as applicable for the All India Quota seats as per the prevalent NCISM / NCH rules and regulations, State Policy and the relevant rules of institutions applicable to the Self Financing All India Quota will apply.
- (viii)(a). All Communications regarding Counselling will be displayed / available through the official website only and any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available immediately on the website www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in.
 - (b). The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of release of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices,

- notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses under All India Quota 2022 2023 session.
- (ix) (a). Candidates can exercise their option for the course and the college of their own choice at the time of counselling, and allotment is subject to availability of seats.
 - (b). Individual request for transfer of College or change of course will not be allowed after allotment of seat is made during the same phase of counselling. A candidate is eligible for re-allotment only during subsequent phase of counselling based on rank and one should have joined the Self-Financing College to which one was allotted under All India Quota during earlier phase of Counselling.
- (x) The vacancies arising after the All India Quota Counselling will be converted into State Quota and it will be filled by the State Government as per rules and policies of Govt. of Tamil Nadu.
- (xi) Counselling/allotment for the seats newly created due to provision of seat matrix after the commencement of first phase counselling by the TN Dr. MGR Medical University or due to the orders/interim orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court Madras after the commencement of 1st phase counselling will be done only during 2nd phase of counselling, but within the cut off date of UG Courses admission as laid down by the regulatory bodies viz. MoA/NCISM/NCH.
- (xii) Mutual transfers will not be allowed under any circumstances.
- (xiii) The candidate is eligible to opt for any of the courses viz. BSMS / BAMS / BHMS course under All India Quota in Self-financing colleges based on his/her eligibility and merit marks obtained in NEET 2022.
- (xiv)Those who obtained allotment order to a particular course in a Self Financing college under All India Quota during the counselling do not join within the stipulated time to that particular course and college to which they are allotted, will not be considered for admission at any point of time later.
- (xv) Counselling schedule will be made available on the website only.
- (xvi) COVID INSTRUCTION :-

The candidates and their parents are instructed to follow the standard preventive measures of COVID-19 as per Government orders from time to time.

10 TUITION FEES:

The Tuition Fees for BSMS, BAMS and BHMS courses under All India Quota in Self Financing Medical Colleges shall be collected as fixed by the Hon'ble Justice N.V. Balasubramanian Committee for the fixation of Fee for Self - Financing Professional Educational Institutions for the year 2022 - 2023.

Any modification in the Fee structure for the academic year 2022 - 2023 as fixed by the Fee Fixation Committee will be intimated at the time of counselling / Admission.

- (a) Detailed information regarding Tuition Fees, Special Fees, Caution Deposit, Scholarship, Fee Concession, Hostel Facilities, University Registration Fees, Curriculum Examination Fees, etc. can be obtained from the Head of the Institution in which the candidate joins.
- (b) All the candidates attending IM & H UG courses counselling for All India Quota seats will have to remit a **non-refundable amount of Rs.1,000**/- (Rupees One Thousand only) **as cash** towards processing fee for Counselling before signing attendance register meant for participating in the counselling. The procedure of online payment is mentioned in Clause 25 of this prospectus.
- (c) The candidates who are selected at the time of counselling (Under All India Quota Seats in Self-Financing IM & H College) shall remit a non-refundable sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) towards tuition fees as cash at the time of receipt of the allotment orders. After the conduct of Registration Subcommittee meeting by the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University this amount will be transferred to the Self Financing Medical Colleges concerned to get adjusted against the Tuition Fees to be paid by the candidates. If the candidate fails to join the course after getting allotment order under All India Quota Seats within the stipulated time he/she will forfeit this amount and the seat allotted.
 - (d) If any amount remains due from the student as a result of revision of fees if any, it shall be payable by the student. An undertaking to pay any amount that may become due as and when the fee structure is revised should be given to the Head of Institution at the time of Admission.
- Same passport size photograph which was uploaded in NEET UG-2022 examination must be fixed in the application form. It should also be pasted in the attendance sheet maintained at the counselling hall and also should be submitted at the time of admission at the allotted College.

19 **DISCONTINUATION FEES:** (i) Candidates selected for admission and his/her parent /guardian will have to execute an Agreement Bond as prescribed in Annexure-III. Failure to execute the Agreement Bond will lead to cancellation of selection. (ii) Candidates who discontinue the course on or after the last cut off date for admission process for the academic session 2022 - 2023 and on any date of the subsequent years are bound by the bond and thereby they shall have to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) as penalty for having breached the contract in the bond by means of Demand Draft in favour of "The Director of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai-106" payable at Chennai. Note: This penalty is only for candidates who discontinue the course and not for re-allotment and movement from one to another category. 20 The candidates will be required to undergo Medical Examination at the college to which they are allotted before the Medical Board on the date notified by the authorities of the college. Only those candidates found medically fit will be admitted and be permitted to pay the fees. 21 Enquiry or any correspondence regarding the selection of candidates will not be entertained. 22 Ragging: The Candidates who join BSMS/BAMS/ BHMS Course should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging.
